Dear Scholarship Applicant:

The Association of the United States Army, St. Louis Gateway Chapter is pleased to announce the availability of merit scholarships, which will be awarded on April 22, 2012. These scholarships will be from \$1,000.<sup>00</sup> to \$3,000.<sup>00</sup>. Last year, 22 scholarships were awarded. There are three scholarship groups. In order to be eligible a student must be in one of the following categories:

## ARMY PERSONNEL ATTENDING COLLEGE

1. Active Army personnel.
2. National Guard & Reserve Students
3. A spouse of the above individuals.

## HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

1. A parent who is currently a member of any active, guard or reserve component of the U.S. Army.
2. A parent who served in the US Army, Guard or Reserve
3. The student is in a High School Army JROTC program.

## HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

1. A parent who currently works for a defense contractor or a defense agency.

These scholarships recognize a student's academic and leadership achievements and are available to high school seniors, enlisted Army personnel and Army ROTC students in the Gateway Chapter Region which include the Missouri counties of St. Louis, City and County, Jefferson, Warren, Franklin, St. Charles and Lincoln. In Illinois, the counties include Calhoun, Jersey, Madison, St. Clair and Monroe.

In order to enter the selection process, applicants must submit all of the following materials no later than March 9, 2012:

## First time college bound high school students (Both Classes)

- 1) Completed scholarship application
- 2) Admission letter from the college, university or institution of higher learning
- 3) Official academic transcripts – please indicate if the school is on a 4.0 or 5.0 scale.
- 4) Copy of post-secondary admission test score: ACT, SAT
- 5) List of extracurricular activities and community service
- 6) Recommendations – two letters from a non-family member, one must be from a teacher
- 7) Essay as described on application form

## Army personnel attending college

- 1) Completed scholarship application
- 2) Official academic transcripts
- 3) List of extracurricular activities and community service
- 4) Recommendations – two letters from a non-family member
- 5) Service record
- 6) Rank and specialty

The scholarships will be presented at the St. Louis Gateway Chapter's Annual Leadership Awards banquet in April 2012. You must attend the banquet in order to receive a scholarship.
